



NASA Rally Sport would like to hold a car race in your area! We are a national organization that specializes in a unique form of racing called "rally racing". This form of racing is quite different from what you may picture as car racing and has these characteristics:

- no oval race track or road course is used;
- all racing takes place on existing public roads that are legally closed during the event;
- only one car starts the course each minute--the racing is against the clock.

Rally races can exist only with cooperation of the local community. Fundamentally, it is a "let us use your roads for a few hours" for a typical economic benefit of \$90,000 in direct spending on food, lodging, and fuel from the racers.

NASA Rally Sport has held events on gravel roads, paved roads, and dirt roads. We have raced on roads owned and managed by towns, counties, states, the Bureau of Land Management, Indian tribes, corporate landowners (including companies) and private land owners. Each event is negotiated with the owners of roads are required for a single event.

Naturally, safety procedures and a sizeable liability insurance policy is very similar to NASCAR. We are listed as 'named insureds'. We will happily provide you with a copy for review. It is also customary for us to provide a copy of our insurance policy to your organization's records. In addition, we will provide you with "an approval pending insurance" which allows you to host the event.

The inconvenience of a rally is minimal. There are no spectators or no residents are affected. The only inconvenience is the temporary closure of roads, but, when the roads are closed, it is a good time for a person to do some maintenance work.
